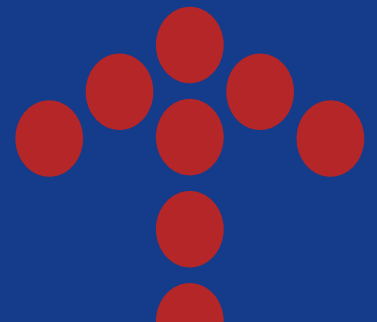

Our Program has a Vision

Through service planning, case management, and transitional housing, youth will become increasingly self-sufficient by taking care of basic needs and obtaining skills and experience needed for employment.



Since beginning the program in March, 2010, to help youth develop knowledge, skills, and connections to make a successful transition to living on their own, we are proud to announce:

- 10 youth graduated with their High School Diplomas
- 6 youth completed the CRH ILP and moved into transitional housing
- 3 youth secured employment
- 6 youth opened bank accounts and established a savings account
- 20 youth obtained their birth certificates, social security cards, and California IDs
- 17 youth attend weekly Independent Living Skills Group, career development classes, healthy relationship group, and receive one-one weekly development with ILP staff
- 7 youth completed their FAFSA (Free Applications for student Aid) in order to pursue a college education

HOWARD J. BOSCUS OUTSTANDING PHILANTHROPIST

In November, the Children's Receiving Home of Sacramento received an exceptional gift from the estate of Mr. Howard Boscus. In life, Howard Boscus worked hard, loved family, and quietly gave to help others in need. In death, he gave the vast majority of his wealth away to benefit eleven local charities that help children and others in need.

Howard was a hard working, frugal, quiet gentleman who loved business. He was a veteran of World War II, serving with the 15th Air Force in North Africa and Italy, and a retired Vice President of Wells Fargo Bank serving many years in Sacramento as a Senior Loan Officer of the Valley Division.

The Children's Receiving Home was fortunate to receive \$1.8 million from his estate as well as a portion of the remaining proceeds when the estate closes. As part of the endowment the funds will be invested, with a portion of the earnings made available each year for vital programs and services.

"In his estate planning, Howard merely continued what he had done in life. In addition to taking care of his immediate and extended family, he also wanted to leave a legacy in the community," shared Dottie Linden, Estate Co-Trustee. "It was also important to him that the agencies he selected have administrative and Board leadership that was focused, involved and credible."

What Howard really hoped was that his legacy gift would inspire others to do something extraordinary – to experience the joy of giving. "Howard did not desire recognition for his contributions, but instead, he wanted his

legacy to inspire others to consider charitable contributions in their estate planning," said Dottie. "He always wondered why more people who were capable of giving chose not to include charitable gifts in their estate plans. He felt they missed experiencing the true joy that comes from giving to your community."

Howard and his wife Millie (who preceded him in death in 1985) were longtime residents of Sacramento. He was the patriarch of his family and loyal to, and loved by, many friends.

On behalf of the children and families that we serve, our staff and Board of Directors, the Children's Receiving Home of Sacramento is tremendously grateful.
